

# Your Legal Options When Families Fight

Find your situation below and identify your legal option

## Probate Issues

The estate isn't being administered properly, or you're being excluded from the process.

- Challenge who's been appointed as the personal representative
- Petition the court to compel proper notice to all heirs
- Request court oversight to ensure fair administration

## Guardian and Conservator Concerns

Someone with authority over your parent isn't acting in their best interest.

- Petition to remove the guardian or conservator
- Request a formal accounting of funds (conservatorship)
- Ask the court to appoint a neutral party

## Power of Attorney Abuse

The agent is misusing funds, refusing to communicate, or blocking access to family members

- Ask the court to review the agent's conduct
- Petition to suspend or remove their authority
- Request court-ordered accounting

## Suspicious Will or Trust

You believe a will or trust was created or changed under undue influence or when your parent lacked capacity.

- Challenge the will based on undue influence or lack of capacity
- Request investigation into circumstances of signing
- File a contest during probate proceedings

## Trustee Misconduct

The trustee is misusing funds, refusing to communicate, or blocking family access.

- Demand formal accounting under the Prudent Investor Act
- Petition for trustee removal for breach of fiduciary duty
- Seek court supervision of trust administration

## Financial Exploitation

You suspect someone is taking advantage of your parent financially or emotionally.

- File for emergency guardianship or conservatorship
- Freeze contested accounts or assets
- Challenge transactions made under undue influence
